## WHAT'S NEW IN THERAPY FOR MALE ANDROGENETIC ALOPECIA?

- ☐ Platelet-rich plasma is a non-pharmacological option demonstrating an improvement in hair count after several months.
- ☐ Use of light devices with wavelengths of between 630 and 660 nm, known as low-level laser therapy, can be used at home every day for 15-30 min., there is a lack of evidence about the efficacy of these devices.



## ☐ Pipeline of new treatments:

- □ Pyrilutamide and GT20029 are being studied as topical antagonists of the androgen receptor,
- ☐ Use of subcutaneous botulinum toxin in the scalp might improve AGA.
- ☐ Scalp threading might increase the total hair count as growth factors are released during implantation.
- ☐ Topical Cetrizine is an another option with promising results.

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
