



DERMA PEARLS : THERAPEUTICS- 8

CALCIPOTRIOL FOR FLAT FACIAL SEBORRHEIC KERATOSIS

- Seborrheic keratosis is the most common slow-growing, benign epithelial tumour, usually appearing on sun-exposed areas.
- Treatment modalities for seborrheic keratosis may be uncomfortable and/or time-consuming.
- A case series of 12 patients with solitary seborrheic keratosis localized on the face treated with 0.005% calcipotriol ointment.
- Treatment lasted 3-8 months and resulted in complete regression of the lesions.
